**LICENSE FOR SASKATOON SEARCH AND RESCUE INC. TO USE A PORTION OF FORMER FIRE STATION No. 3**

City Council will consider a report from Administration at the Public Hearing of City Council to be held on **Monday, February 25, 2019 at 6:00 p.m., Council Chambers, City Hall** recommending:

That City Council authorize a license for Saskatoon Search and Rescue Inc. (SSAR) to use a portion of former Fire Station No. 3, located at 1906 York Avenue, for a three-year term at \$1.00 per year.

- SSAR is a non-profit organization that supports various authorities, including the Saskatoon Fire Department, in emergency situations.
- Former Fire Station No. 3 was relocated earlier this year and although officially closed, it is still partially occupied by the Saskatoon Fire Department.
- SSAR wants to use a portion of Fire Station No. 3 for office space and to store equipment.

*The Cities Act* and City Council Bylaw 8171 require that City Council give Public Notice prior to leasing property for an amount less than market value and without a public offering.
