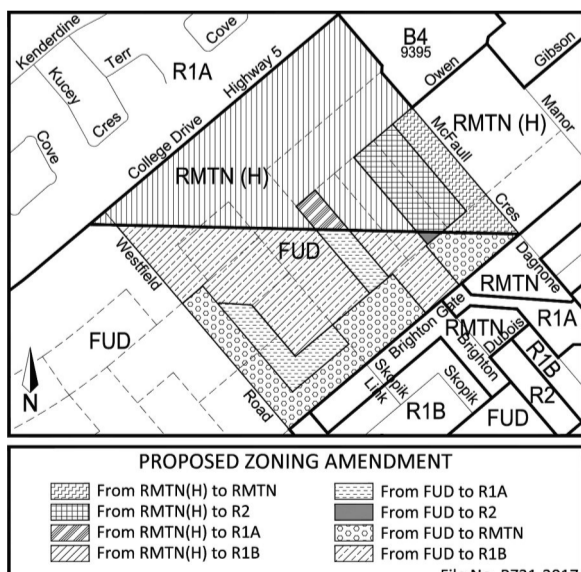
## ZONING NOTICE

### BRIGHTON NEIGHBOURHOOD

#### PROPOSED ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO. 9534

Saskatoon City Council will consider an amendment to the City's Zoning Bylaw (No. 8770) regarding land in the Brighton neighbourhood, submitted by Dream Development. By way of Bylaw No. 9534, The Zoning Amendment Bylaw, 2018 (No. 22), the zoning designation of land in the Brighton neighbourhood, as outlined in the map below, will be amended from FUD – Future Urban Development District and RMTN (H) – Townhouse Residential District to RMTN, R1A – One-Unit Residential District, R1B – Small Lot One-Unit Residential District, and R2 – One- and Two-Unit Residential District.

**LEGAL DESCRIPTION** – Parcel C – Plan No. 102194759 and Part of Reg'd Plan No. 93S04586, Parcel B – Plan No. 102194759, & N 1/2 Sec 30-TWP 36 RGE. 4-W. 3rd Mer.



**REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT** – Dream Development is proposing to amend the zoning of the subject sites to facilitate development of one and two-unit dwellings, townhouse style multiple-unit dwellings, and park space. These uses align with the approved Brighton Neighbourhood Concept Plan, and this zoning amendment is required to permit development in this area of the neighbourhood to proceed.
