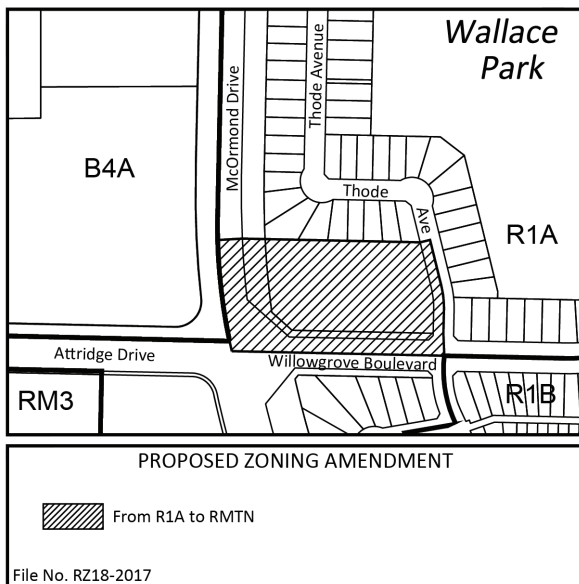

## ZONING NOTICE

### WILLOWGROVE NEIGHBOURHOOD PROPOSED ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO. 9516

Saskatoon City Council will further consider the amendment to the City's Zoning Bylaw (No. 8770) proposed by Innovative Residential to rezone 107 Thode Avenue, located in the Willowgrove Neighbourhood. By way of Bylaw No. 9516, The Zoning Amendment Bylaw, 2018 (No. 15), 107 Thode Ave is proposed to be rezoned from R1A – One Unit Residential District to RMTN – Townhouse Residential District.

**LEGAL DESCRIPTION** – Parcel AA, Plan 101749248, Surface Parcel 153208289



**REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT** – The proposed zoning of 107 Thode Avenue to RMTN – Townhouse Residential District will accommodate future development of the site, in accordance with the Willowgrove Neighbourhood Concept Plan with the development standards of the RMTN zoning district, such as a low-density dwelling group.
