



## **HOMEBOUND VOTING WILL BE CONDUCTED ON OCTOBER 21, 24 & 26**

City Council has established homebound voting for voters who, due to disability or limited mobility, are unable to leave their residence to vote at an established polling place. Their resident caregivers may also vote using this service.

If you wish to use this service, **you must fill out an application form and file it with the Returning Officer no later than Friday, October 14, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.** Application forms are available at [saskatoon.ca/election2016](http://saskatoon.ca/election2016) or from the City Clerk's Office at City Hall, , 222-3rd Avenue North.

You will then be advised of the date and time an Election Official will visit your home to take your vote. When the Election Official visits your home, you will be required to provide identification.
