

Mail-In Ballot Application

All eligible voters have the option to apply for mail-in ballot.

<p>Electronic applications are accepted until October 30, 2020 In-person applications are accepted until November 8, 2020</p>

To use the mail-in ballot opportunity, you are required to complete the following:

- Voter registration and mail-in ballot application form
- Voter and witness declaration form (an acceptable witness is any eligible voter in the 2020 Saskatoon civic election)
- Digital picture or photocopy of your government issued photo ID or acceptable forms of identification.

A list of options to provide your registration and application package to the Election Office:

- E-mail - The voter registration and mail-in ballot application package can be printed, completed and e-mailed to the Election Office at elections@saskatoon.ca. All required documents must accompany the completed registration and application forms.
- Mail - The voter registration and mail-in ballot application package can be printed, completed and mailed to the Election Office at 226 Cardinal Crescent, S7L 6H8. All required documents must accompany the completed registration and application forms.
- In-person at the election office - Print and complete the registration form and application ahead of time to make your experience quicker.

The Elections Office is taking precaution to ensure safe social distancing and sanitizing measures are in place to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

The identification documents to be provided is intended for the use of the 2020 Civic Election only. Please be advised the information provided will be verified by the Election Office and destroyed once verification is complete. 1. I am a Canadian citizen
2. I have resided in Saskatchewan for at least six (6) consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election.
3. I am the full age of 18 years or will attain the full age of 18 years on or before election day
4. I have not already voted at this election.
5. On the day of the election, I:
 - have resided for at least three (3) consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election in or on land now in the City of Saskatoon; or
 - have been the owner of assessable land situated in the City of Saskatoon for at least three consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election. Address of land _____
6. On the day of the election, I have resided for at least three (3) consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election in or on land now in the:
 - Saskatoon Public School Division No. 13 of Saskatchewan and qualify as a voter of the school division; or
 - St. Paul's Catholic Separate School Division No. 20 of Saskatchewan and I am of the religious faith of the minority that established the separate school division and qualify as a voter of the school division.
7. I am qualified to vote in the Local Government Elections being held in the City of Saskatoon; I have completed a Voter's registration Form; and I request that a mail-in ballot be issued to me.

The personal information provided in this form is intended for the use of the 2020 Saskatoon Civic Election only. The personal information will be used to verify voter eligibility in the 2020 Saskatoon Civic Election in accordance with the Election Bylaw No. 8191 and *The Local Authority Freedom of Information Protection of Privacy Act*. A candidate or candidate agent may request to view voter's registration forms, declarations of persons requesting mail-in ballots and voter confirmation envelopes and certificate at the elections office, in accordance with The Election Bylaw No. 8191.
