

It's Easy to Vote by Mail



Vote For Your Candidate(s)



- Remove the ballot from **Ballot Security Envelope A**.
- The top of the ballot will tell you the number of candidates you are able to vote for.
- Fill in the oval to the **left** side of the candidate(s) name to make your choice. **Use a blue or black ball point pen, not a pencil.**
- After you have filled in the ballot, refold it back up along the existing fold line.
- Place ballot back in **Ballot Security Envelope A**.

Make Your Vote Safe & Secure



- Place sealed **Envelope A** into **Voter Confirmation Envelope B** and seal **Envelope B**.
- Read, date and sign the certificate on the front of **Voter Confirmation Envelope B**. **Be sure to sign on the line above Signature of Voter.**
- Place sealed **Envelope B** into **Envelope C**. Seal **Envelope C**.

You are Almost Finished Voting by Mail



- Write your return address in the space provided on **Envelope C**, the postage-paid, self-addressed mailing envelope.
- Return **Envelope C** to the Civic Election Office one of three ways:
 - **Regular mail:** place postage-paid, self-addressed Envelope C in a mailbox
 - **Courier:** deliver to 226 Cardinal Crescent, Saskatoon, SK S7L 6H8
 - **In-person:** deliver to 226 Cardinal Crescent, Saskatoon, SK S7L 6H8
- Due to COVID-19, consider delays with Canada Post.

IMPORTANT:

Mail-in ballots must be received at the civic election office before close of polls (8:00 pm) on Election Day, November 9, 2020. Any ballots received after 8:00 pm are considered spoiled and not counted.
