


Submission of Hold Documents for Inspection (Shop Drawings, Letter of Assurance, Ventilation Verification Certificate, & Air Tightness Certificate)

During the review process of your permit, a hold will be created on the permit for each mandatory document required before a permit will be completed. This following document will provide instructions on how to upload your document to each hold.

Log into your e-permitting account using the following link https://lmspublic.saskatoon.ca/lms/pub/lmsguest/Welcome.aspx







Enter your username and password and click Sign In.


Click on My Activities





The "my activities" tab will show permits at all statuses. The "my projects" tab will show projects that you create which can contain multiple permits. Under Details, in the right column, you will find your hold section. Each document will have a separate hold.






To upload the appropriate document to the hold, click on the specific hold and a pop up box will appear.


Fill in the Response Box with the description of document you are uploading.

Next, hit +Upload






You will need to click on Choose File before selecting the appropriate document.



Choose the file you want to attach and then hit Upload. Once the document has finished uploading, your Permit Hold Screen should have a description in Response and you should see a file under File Name.







You can now hit Save & Close.

Follow the same steps for all Holds listed for that permit. You will see the status change from Active to Awaiting Review if the document was uploaded correctly.

You may now go ahead and book your inspection using your e-permitting portal. Once the inspector has reviewed the hold and document attached, they will release the hold and your e-permitting hold status will change to Released and the red flag will disappear.
