

Pop-Up Gallery: Saskatoon Fieldhouse – Information

The Pop-Up Gallery program provides temporary space to local emerging and established Saskatoon artists for public art exhibits. The program takes place in the lobby area of the Saskatoon Fieldhouse.

Program Goals:

- To provide opportunities to local artists for artistic expression in a civic facility
- To connect the public with the work of local artists

Applications are accepted on an on-going basis. Artists may book one exhibition per year. New exhibitions open the 1st and 16th of each month. Bookings are currently being accepted for dates between March 16, 2025 – August 31, 2025.

Priority will be given to artists from 2SLGBTQQIA+, BIPOC, people with disabilities, and other equity deserving groups and/or artists who want to exhibit work that is inspired by the Saskatoon Fieldhouse. Artwork displayed must be suitable for an all-ages civic facility.

Space Available:

- 15-foot-wide x 6-foot-tall metal grid wall
 - S hooks and zip ties for hanging work are provided

Use of Space:

- Use the metal grid wall to exhibit artwork; artwork must not protrude more than 12 inches from the grid wall
- The grid wall panels must remain in place, next to the wall.
- Artwork may be available for sale; artists are responsible for facilitating any sales.
- The City of Saskatoon is not responsible for any loss or damage to artwork exhibited in the Pop-up Gallery

Notification:

Artists will receive an email notification regarding their booking within two weeks of their application submission.

September 1- May 31 Monday - Friday: 6:30 am to 10:00 pm Saturday and Sunday: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm


June 1 – August 31 Monday - Friday: 6:30 am to 9:00 pm Saturday and Sunday: 9:00 am to 3:00 pm

Application Process

□ brief description of exhibition for publication on City website (maximum 25 words);
□ 2 -3 images of the work to be exhibited
□ bio or c.v. of the artist(s) involved in the exhibition
