Important Information for 2021

Dear Allotment Gardener.

The City of Saskatoon Parks Department is happy to announce that the Garden Allotment plots will be moving to their brand new location on Gladstone Crescent for the 2021 season.

Construction is scheduled for completion by mid May 2021 with a season opening date of May 21, 2021 weather permitting. This information brochure is designed to answer any questions you may have regarding the move, and to confirm your interest in renting a plot in 2021.

Gardeners who rented a garden plot at the 37th Street location in 2020 will be given first opportunity to rent a plot at the new site. There are enough plots for all existing gardeners. **To guarantee your spot**, **please let us know if you are interested in renting a plot for the 2021 season no later than March 19, 2021**. To confirm please call 306-975-3300 or email Parks@saskatoon.ca with "allotment gardens" in the subject line. Once we receive confirmation of your interest, we will assign you a plot number and send out your annual agreement. Plots will be assigned to users in first-come first-serve order. Please let us know if you prefer a full or half sized plot in your response.

New location:



The new allotment gardens are located at 218 Gladstone Crescent.

Directions:

Heading north on Wanuskewin Rd, turn left at Arthur Rose Avenue and take the next left onto Gladstone Cres.

New site layout:



- ➤ There are 95 Garden plots at the new site, 77 are full sized and 18 are half sized.
 - There will be no rental cost increase for 2021.
 - Full size plots are 25 x 40 feet (7.6m x 12.2m). The cost is \$80.85 (\$77.00 plus \$3.85 GST)
 - Half size plots are 25 x 20 feet (7.6m x 6.1m). The cost is \$40.40 (\$38.5 + 1.90 GST)
- New plots have concrete curb edges and access to shared irrigation that is very similar to the system at the previous site.
- > Compost from the City of Saskatoon's compost yards will be added to the gardens in the final phase of construction.
- The adjacent public parking lot is available for allotment garden and ball field users.
- > Two ball diamonds are planned for construction in 2022. Ball field construction activities will not impact the operation of the garden plots.
