Emergencies & Urgent Matters	911	Emergency Services	Any circumstance that poses a risk to life safety or property such as a fire, medical distress, overdose or violence. Including an unhoused person in an unsafe condition or distress.
Non-urgent Matters	306-975-8300	Saskatoon Police Service	Any circumstance that is non-critical.
Needle Pickup	306-975-3030	Saskatoon Fire Department, Operations	A crew will be sent (no lights and sirens) immediately to retrieve the needle. Please provide the location of the needle.
