

CEMETERY PLOTS

A variety of options are available for casket or cremation, including upright monument and flat marker areas as well as religious and non-denominational sections. All plot fees include a mandatory contribution for the first interment to the Perpetual Care Fund that pays for the long-term maintenance of the cemetery. Each additional interment in the same plot requires a contribution to the Perpetual Care Fund.

INTERMENT SERVICES

Includes all aspects of preparing the grave for interment during regular cemetery hours including excavation, setting up the lowering device and greens, closing the grave after the service and seeding the interment site. A portion of this fee also contributes to maintaining the permanent records in the cemetery office for future generations.

MEMORIALIZATION SERVICES

Includes the supply and installation of concrete foundations for upright monuments; installation of flat markers; monument application review; and coordinating installation with monument dealers. Local monument dealers typically include these fees in their monument costs and forward the fee to the cemetery on behalf of the family.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Flowers and Other Memorial Items

- All items placed in the cemetery by the public will be at their own risk. The City of Saskatoon accepts no responsibility for any damaged or missing items.
- Only approved monuments or approved parts thereof are considered permanent items and are permitted to remain in the cemetery year-round.
- All types of flowers are permitted on the grave the day of the burial and will be left for a period of 7 calendar days. Any time after this period, the flowers and other items will be removed and disposed of.
- Cemetery staff will not remove flowers placed in vases that are part of the approved monument. Flowers in containers that are not part of the approved monument will be disposed of.
- Flowerbeds may be planted at some graves. Contact the cemetery office for guidelines.
- All other items placed on a grave, flowerbed, or concrete foundations are considered temporary and are removed and disposed of **weekly**. Items placed on approved monuments that do not meet the monument regulations are also considered temporary and will be removed and disposed of.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- These fees are effective January 1, 2017 and are subject to change without notification.
- **All fees are subject to Goods & Services Tax (G.S.T.) Unless noted**
- All interments require the use of an approved burial vault (except infants and children)
- A **minimum** of 48 hours notice is required for all interments not including weekends and holidays.
- Winter rates are in effect from November 15th through April 30th each year.
