Parking and Travel Assumptions

Note: Numbers are conservative and based on current data from Saskatoon and similar cities.

If 15,000 people attend an event at the Downtown event centre/arena they will arrive by:

63% of attendees will arrive in a private vehicle, with an average of **2.75** passengers per vehicle (for 9,500 people).

A total of 5,200 parking stalls will be available within a five-to-seven-minute walking distance (400 - 600 meters).

- Current available parking in this zone* 3,800: 3,100 spots in parking lots, with an additional 700 spots on the street (doesn't include the 500 spots in the existing Midtown Shopping Centre North Parking Lot).
- New parking stalls to be developed 500: 500 new stalls will be built to replace those lost from the Midtown Shopping Centre North Parking Lot with the potential for more if determined to be needed.
- Potential Private Parking Stalls 900: Five large private lots that could be made available as public paid parking available after hours.

Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) - 2,250: Based on estimate of 15 per cent of people travelling via BRT.

Car sharing, charter or drop-off - 2,500: Based on existing percentage of people (17%) travelling to events this way.

Alternative modes of travel (i.e., walking or cycling) - 750: Conservatively based on five per cent of people walking or cycling from home, hotel or place of work.

These people include:

- 6,000 people currently living within 15-minute walking distance
- 18,000 working downtown
- Those staying in one of 1,700 rooms

^{*} Hundreds of additional off-street public parking stalls are within a short walking distance of the Midtown Shopping Centre (e.g. Toys R Us) which would provide shelter over a longer walking distance.
