Annual Report of Business Information for the City of Saskatoon

Business License Program

The City of Saskatoon Community Services Department, Business License Program, licenses all businesses operating from a fixed address within Saskatoon. This includes all home based businesses and all businesses operating from commercial and industrial locations.

The Business License Program processes over 6,800 new business applications and license renewals annually. All data contained in this publication was obtained by the City of Saskatoon through the Business License Program.

This publication provides a summary of business activity in Saskatoon including information on:

- the Online Business Directory,
- · New Businesses,



- Home Based Businesses (those operating in residential areas), and
- Commercial/Industrial Businesses (those operating in traditional business areas), including employment information.

Total Licensed Businesses

In 2003, there was a total of 6,890 licensed businesses in Saskatoon. Table 1 identifies the total number of home based businesses and commercial/industrial businesses licensed by the Business License Program from 1998 to 2003.

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New Businesses

The City of Saskatoon Business License Program issued 791 new business licenses in 2003. Table 2 provides the number of new business licenses issued for the years 1998 to 2003.




Figure 1: New Licensed Businesses, 1998–2003

As shown in Figure 1, the number of new licensed home based businesses continues to exceed the number of new licensed commercial/industrial businesses.

Table 4 represents the number of new home based business license applications approved by major business sector for the years 1999 to 2003. Home based businesses are classified under six major business sector types:

• The Building/Construction Related Sector includes all commercial and residential contractors, plumbers, electricians, landscapers, home renovation experts, etc.

- The Business/Professional Sector includes insurance agents, web designers, accountants, lawyers, engineers, financial advisors, and many other related services.
- The Health/Wellness/Education Sector includes many health and medical services such as massage therapists, nutritionists, psychologists, fitness consultants, instructors, and other teaching services.
- The Manufacturing/Transport/ Wholesale Sector consists of couriers, limousine services, movers, wholesale distributors, etc.
- The Personal/Household Sector includes caterers, entertainers, artists, interior decorators, travel agents, etc.
- The Repair/Maintenance Sector includes janitorial services, upholstery, handyman services, and other mobile repair services.

Special Projects

2003 was a busy year for the Business License Program. Along with managing over 6,800 business licenses, the Business License Program managed to:

- provide supporting data to the Regional Retail Study;
- complete the public consultation program associated with the City's pawn shop clustering review;
- provide support to the Online Business Directory;
- initiate a comprehensive review of business license database, and data collection techniques;
- provide a fall edition of *Business Profile*; and
- update the Business License Program webpage, including a link to the Saskatchewan Home Based Business Association webpage.

2004 will also be a busy year for the Business License Program. The special projects the Business License Program will be working on in 2004, include:

- reviewing and rewriting the Business License Bylaw;
- completing the pawn shop clustering review, including amendments to the Business License Bylaw and Zoning Bylaw;
- reviewing permitted home based businesses;
- investigating an online application and renewal process for business licenses;
- preparing updated business license and home based business brochures;
- implementing internal audit recommendations, including changes to the bylaw enforcement program; and
- providing a fall edition of *Business Profile*.

Commercial/Industrial Businesses




Figure 2: Commercial/Industrial Businesses by Major Business Sector, 2000–2003

In 2003, Saskatoon had a total of 5,112 licensed commercial/industrial businesses. Table 7 and Figure 2 provide a breakdown of businesses by major business sector.

Evaluation and processing of Enterprise Zone Initiatives

After the first year of operation, a total of 12 major commercial, industrial, and residential projects have received assistance totaling over \$136,000 towards relocating, renovating, expanding, or constructing new developments in the Enterprise Zone.

As well, over \$38,000 in building and plumbing permit fee rebates have been disbursed to homeowners and commercial industrial owners

who have undertaken construction or renovation within the Enterprise Zone. In 2003, eligibility was expanded to include all forms of retail development within B-Zoned Districts inside the Zone.

The Enterprise Zone includes the neighbourhoods and industrial areas of Westmount, Caswell Hill, King George, Riversdale, Pleasant Hill, Mayfair, Kelsey/Woodlawn, and the West Industrial Area.

Of note

Sector Plans Complete

Considerable work was undertaken in Confederation and University Heights in 2003. The Confederation Sector Plan was approved in conjunction with the Hampton Village Concept Plan in early 2004, while the University Heights Sector Plan will be presented to City Council in mid-2004.




Figure 3: Number of Commercial/Industrial Businesses by Neighbourhood, 2003

Quick facts

- The Service Sector and Retail Sector have the greatest number of employees with 25,191 and 15,575 respectively. The Service Sector had an increase of 1,836 over last year.
- According to the business license data, there are 9,945 people employed by businesses operating in the Central Business District (CBD). That is an increase of 549 over last year's reported figures. (These figures do not include employment for government and non-profit agencies.)




Figure 4: Number of Employees by Neighbourhood, 2003

How Much New Retail Space Has Been Developed in Saskatoon since 2000?

Recently, there has been a significant increase in the overall amount of retail space available in the City of Saskatoon. Over 620,000 square feet of new retail space has been developed since 2000 through the following major projects:

- Preston Crossing Phase I
- 8th Street Relocations (Jubilee Ford and Sherwood sites)
- · Marketplace on Attridge
- Superstore Expansions (8th Street and Confederation)

Home Based Businesses

There was a total of 1,778 licensed home based businesses in Saskatoon in 2003. This was an increase of 14% from the previous year.

Home based businesses account for 26% of the total number of licensed businesses in Saskatoon. Table 10 provides the total number of home based businesses by major business sector for the years 1998 to 2003.

As shown in Table 10 and in Figure 6 (page 7), the Building Construction and Business/Professional Service sectors continue to have the greatest number of businesses in Saskatoon.

Figure 5 (page 7) illustrates the number of licensed home based businesses by neighbourhood.

Saskatoon residential neighbourhoods that contain more than fifty (50) home

based businesses include: Dundonald, Nutana, College Park East, Lakeview, Wildwood, River Heights, Silverwood Heights, Forest Grove, and Silverspring.

Neighbourhoods experiencing the highest number of new home based business applications in 2003 include Dundonald (20), College Park East (19), Forest Grove and Silverspring (18 both), Silverwood Heights (17) and Confederation Park (14).




Figure 5: Number of Home Based Businesses by Neighbourhood, 2003




Figure 6: History of the Home Based Business Sector, 2000–2003
