

The Community Standards Department, Business License Program, licenses all businesses operating from a fixed address within Saskatoon. This includes all home based businesses as well as businesses operating from commercial and industrial locations.

The Business Profile Annual Report provides a summary and analysis of business activity in Saskatoon, including information on new businesses, commercial/industrial businesses, and home based businesses for 2020 and 2021.

All data contained within this publication was obtained by the City of Saskatoon through the Business License Program. All businesses have been classified based on their primary business type or activity according to the North American Industry Classification System (For more information on NAICS, visit statcan.gc.ca/ and search "NAICS 2017" or email infostats@statcan.ca).

#### **Highlights:**

- > 1,171 new business licenses were issued in 2021 compared to 1,086 in 2020 demonstrating a slight rebound in business activities.
- The introduction of Short Term Accommodations to the Business License Program has increased the overall Accommodations & Food Services sector.
- > The data in this profile includes closure information received up to December 31, 2021. Closure information is usually received after the business receives their renewal notice the following year. It is anticipated an additional year of data collection will be required for all business closures that occurred during the COVID-19 pandemic to be reflected in the data.

#### **Total Licensed Businesses**

The City of Saskatoon Business License Program requires all businesses to obtain a license prior to operating. In 2021, there were 12,228 businesses licensed by the program. Figure 1 illustrates the overall business growth in Saskatoon and identifies the total number of home based and commercial/industrial businesses licensed from 2011 to 2021. The total number of businesses has increased by 27% over the previous 10 years.





Figure 2: Total Licensed Businesses by Major Sector, 2021 20% Goods

Saskatoon's total licensed businesses can be divided into two major sectors: (1) goods-producing and (2) servicesproducing. As shown in Figure 2, Saskatoon's economy is primarily made up of services-producing businesses.

Figure 1: Total Licensed Businesses, 2011-2021

#### **New Businesses**

The City of Saskatoon Business License Program issued 1,171 new business licenses in 2021. Figure 4 illustrates the number of new licenses issued for the years 2011 to 2021. The number of new home based businesses continues to exceed the number of new commercial/industrial businesses.

### **Commercial/Industrial Businesses**

In 2021, Saskatoon had a total of 6,864 licensed commercial/industrial businesses representing 56% of all businesses. Table 4 provides a breakdown of businesses by NAICS sectors for the years 2016 to 2021. The Trade (Wholesale and Retail) sector continues to be the most prevalent at 29% of all commercial businesses.



#### **Commercial/Industrial Businesses by Neighbourhood**

Figure 5 illustrates the distribution of commercial/industrial businesses in Saskatoon by neighbourhood. The neighbourhoods with the greatest number of commercial/industrial businesses are Downtown (884), North Industrial (751), Marquis Industrial (460), and Hudson Bay Industrial (451).

#### **New Commercial/Industrial Businesses**

The Business License Program issued 493 new commercial/industrial business licenses in 2021. This represents 42% of all new business license issued. Table 5 shows the number of new commercial/industrial businesses by NAICS sector from 2016 through 2021. Both the Trade sector and Other Services (including personal services, hair salons) have the highest volume of new application (42% of all new commercial applications).

### **Home Based Businesses**

In 2021, there were a total of 5,364 licensed home based businesses. This means 44% of all licensed businesses are home based.

Table 7 summarizes the total number of home based businesses by NAICS sector for the years 2016 to 2021. The number of home based businesses has increased by 40% since 2011. The data in Table 7 indicates the Professional, Scientific & Technical Services along with Accommodation & Food Services have seen the highest growth in these areas. A more detailed breakdown of the total number of home based businesses by NAICS sub-sector can be found in Appendix 3, page 10.

Figure 6 illustrates the total number of licensed home based businesses by neighbourhood. The neighbourhoods with the greatest number of home based businesses are Stonebridge (280), Silverwood Heights (225), Evergreen (218), Hampton Village (210), Willowgrove (199), and Rosewood (175). As newer neighbourhoods such as Rosewood continue being developed with homes, we observe a gradual increase in the number of businesses operating in these residential areas. 

The Business License Program issued 678 new home based business licenses in 2022, representing 58% of all new business licenses issued.
