Traveling Meeting starting at École Victoria School

- 1. Welcome** – Four new Committee members were welcomed and introduced to everyone in attendance.
- 2. Approval of Minutes** – Minutes from March 18, 2023 were approved as circulated.
- 3. Update from Project Manager** – Project Manager gave updates on a number of initiatives including the Pilot Station, Transit Signal priority pilot and BRT Public Art.
- 4. Transit Update** – There is a new Director of Transit, Jim Puffault, who will start June 12th. There will also be some service changes starting in July which are listed on saskatoontransit.ca.
- 5. Committee Member Updates** – No updates from Committee Members
- 6. Station Design Discussion** – Meeting participants provided feedback on three of the four station locations along Broadway Avenue. Each station was laid out in real space through the use of outlines to give a sense of space.

For all sites there were common concerns/feedback about:

- Preserving existing trees
- Preserve brickwork if possible
- Shelter size
- Safety concerns about traction of drain
- Advertising panel – is it really necessary?
- Broadway ambience has to be protected.
- Change information display to be less imposing if possible.
- Don't repeat existing street furniture (e.g., garbage cans, benches)
- Information display could be part of the shelter for smaller footprint
- Don't obstruct business/school/etc. entryways

Updated renderings for these locations will be sourced for future meetings.
