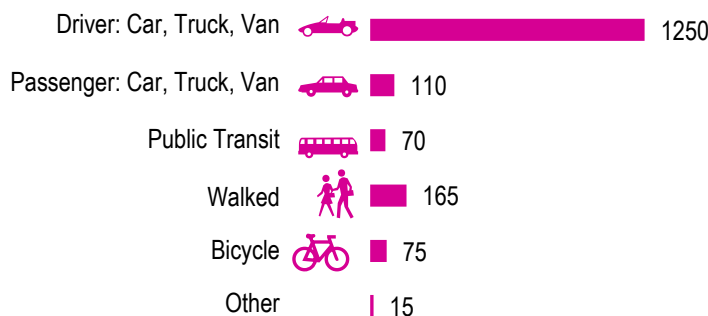

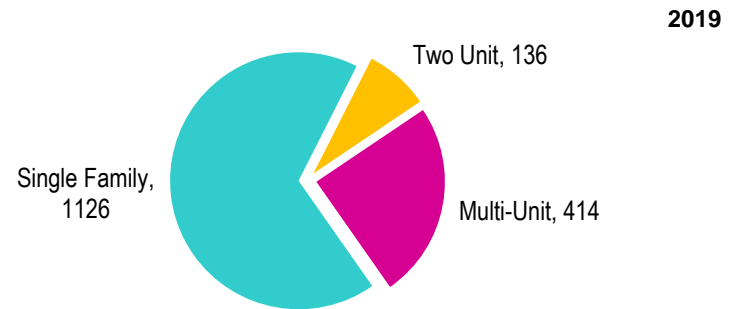

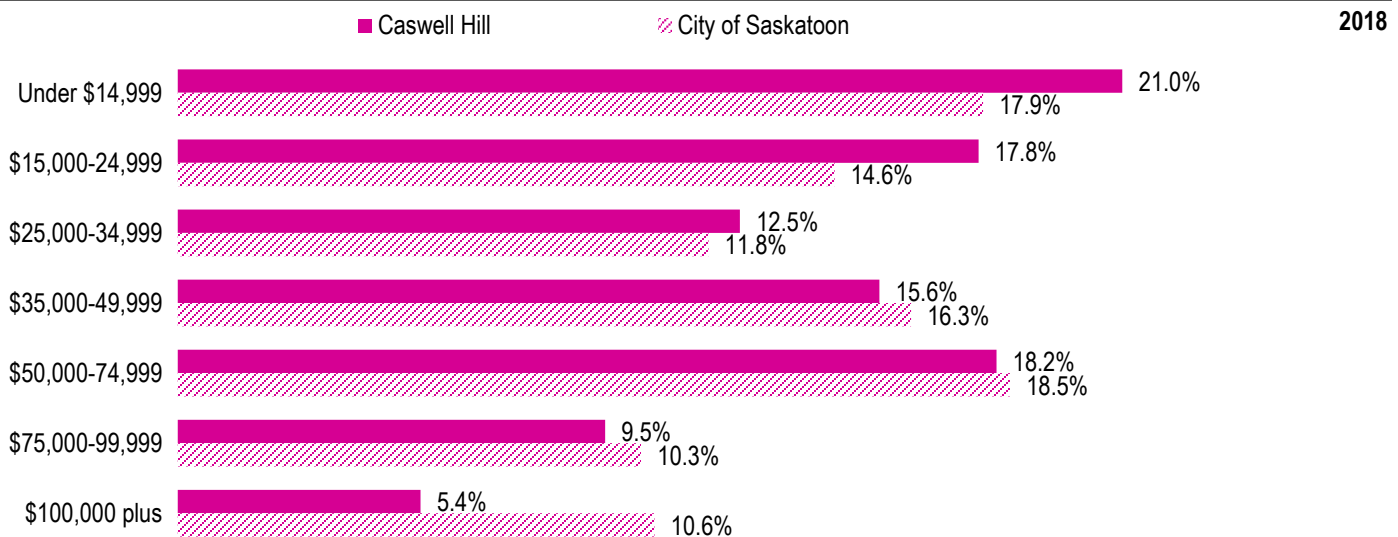

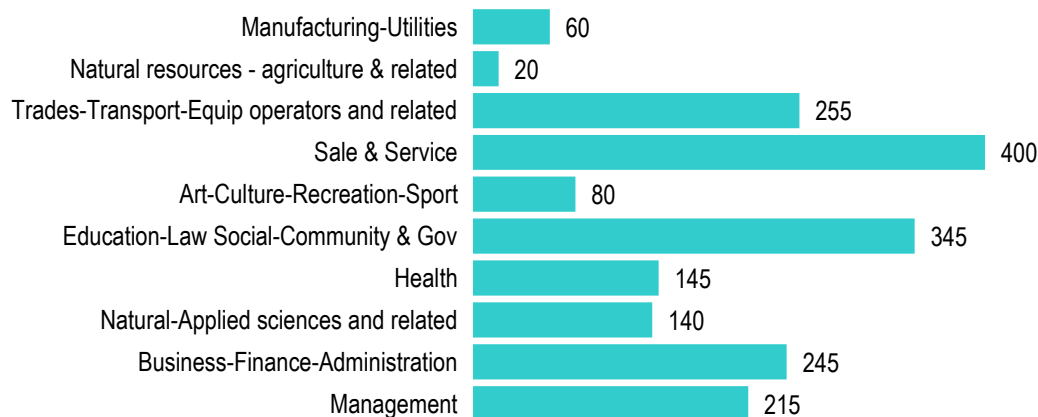
Personal Income
