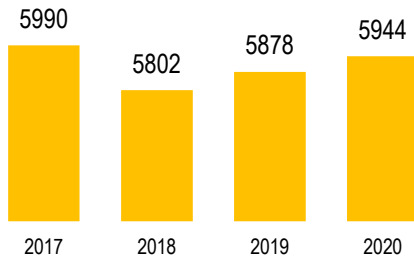

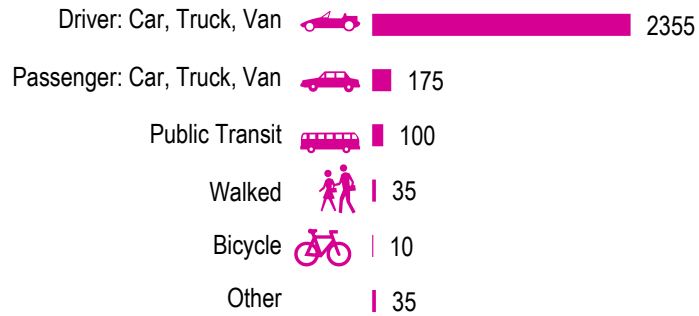

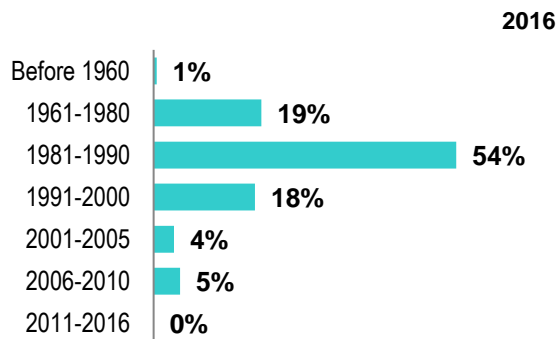

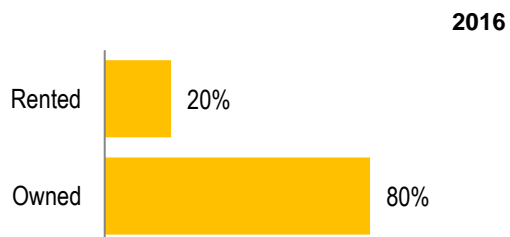

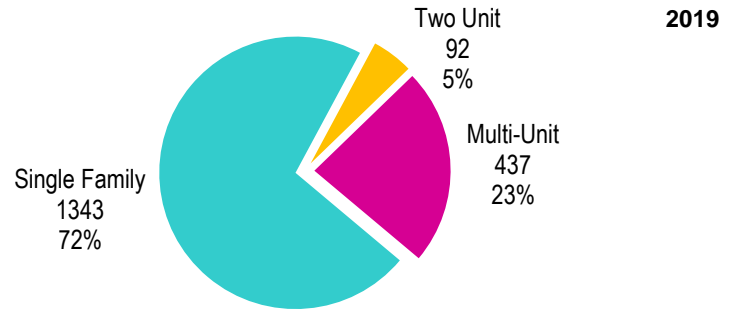

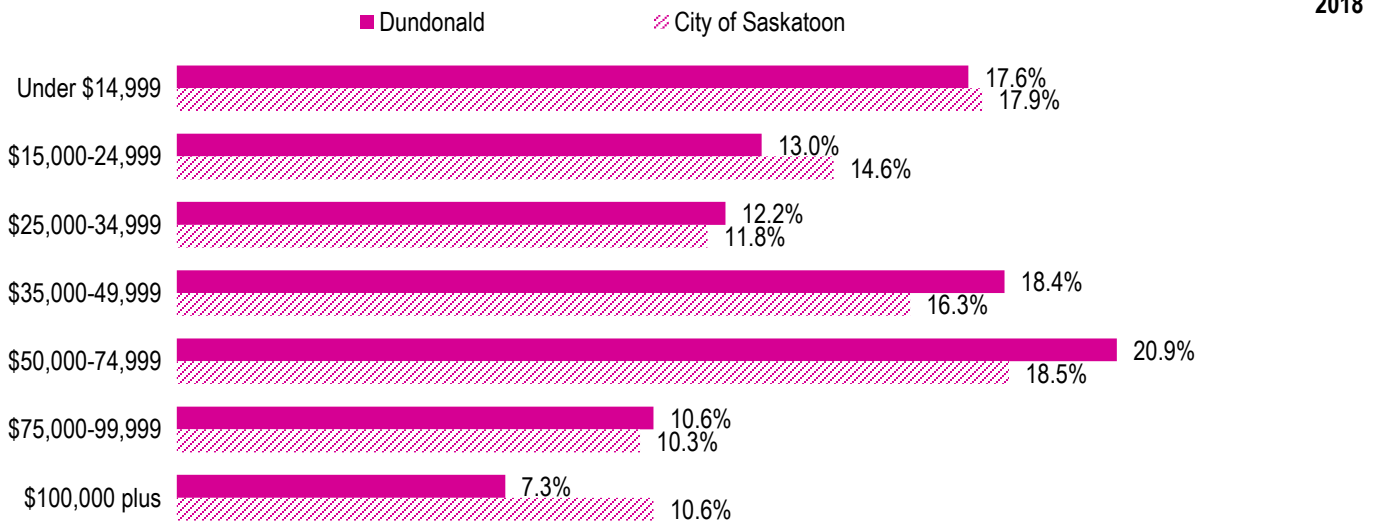

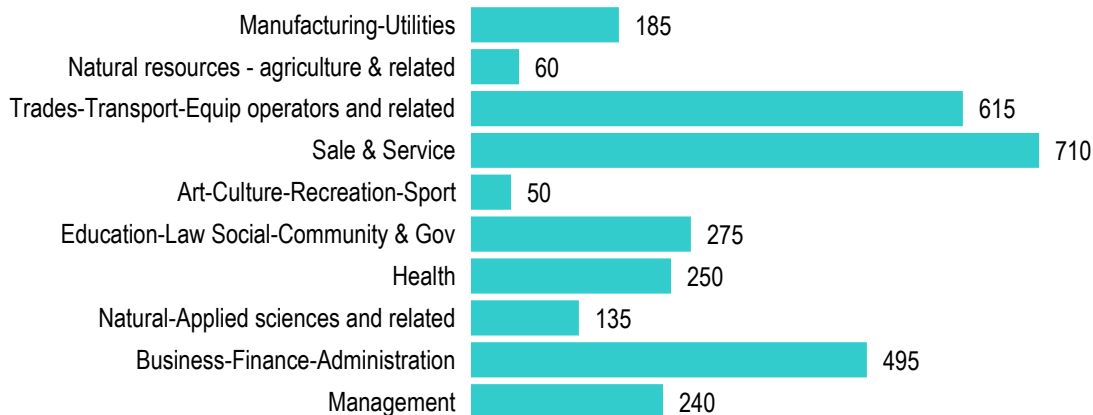
## Personal Income
