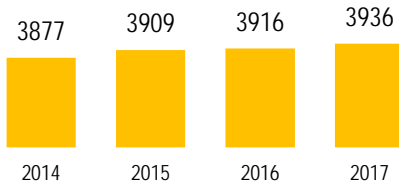

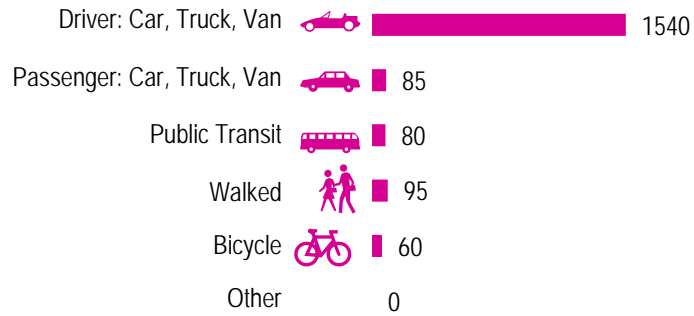

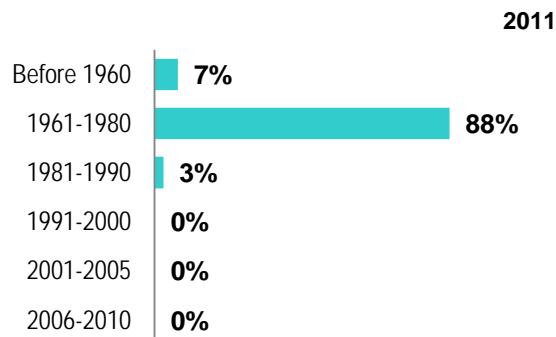

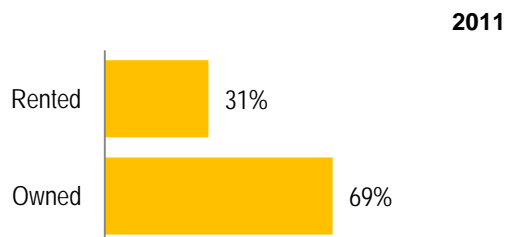

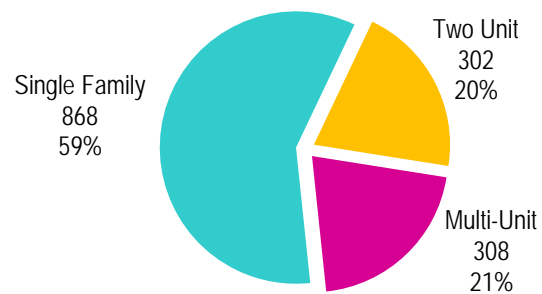

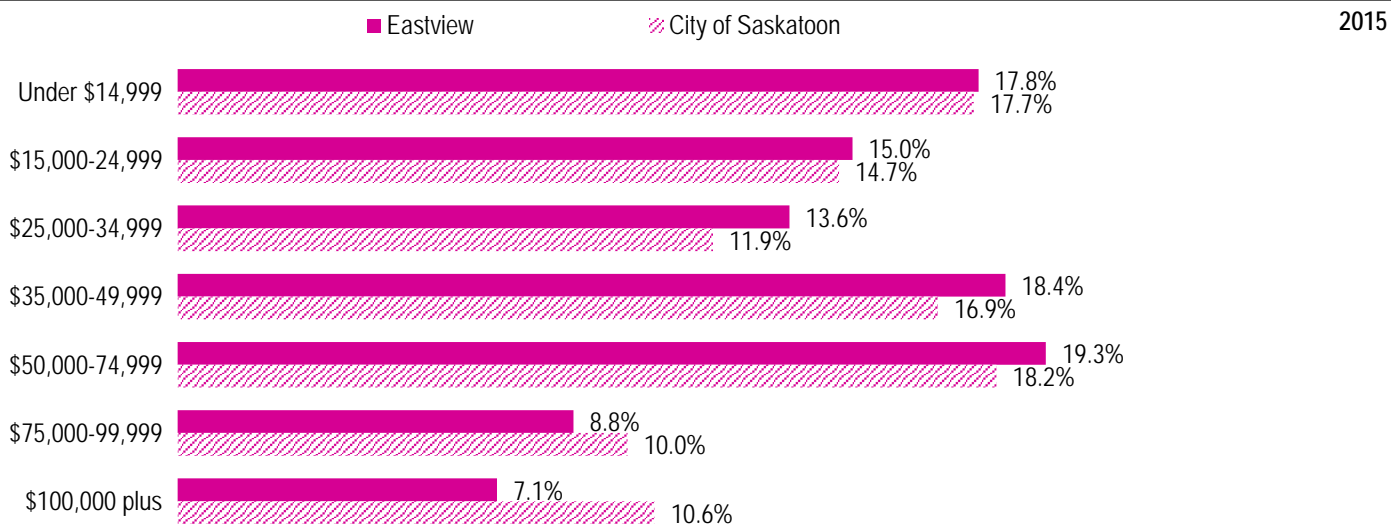

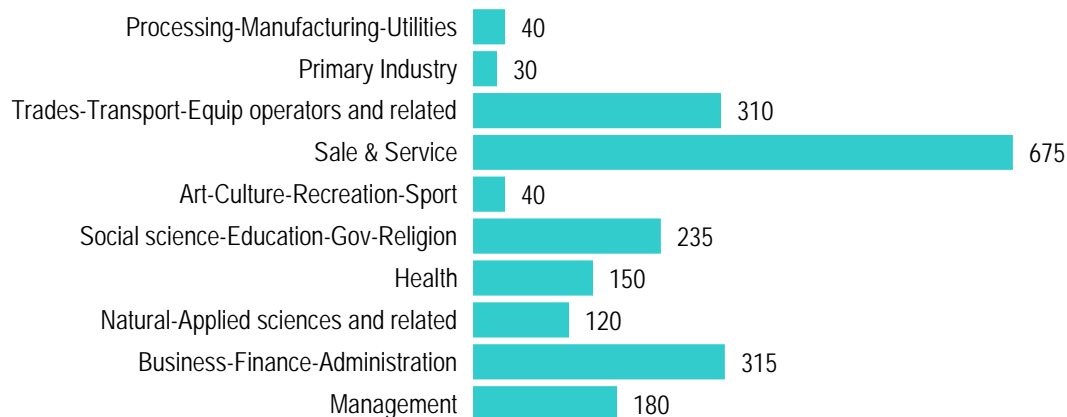
Personal Income
