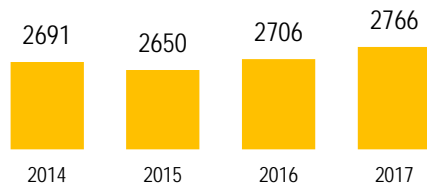

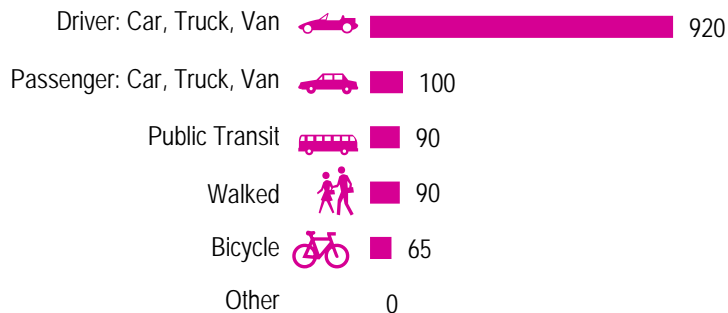

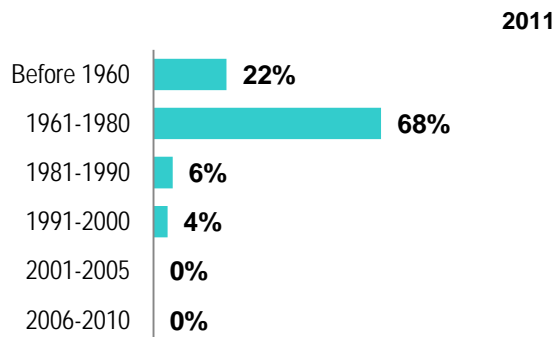

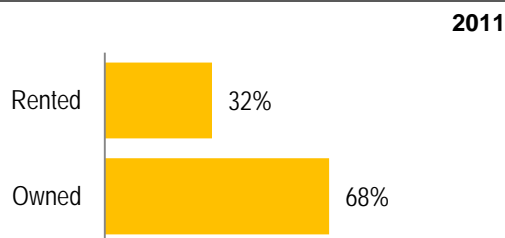

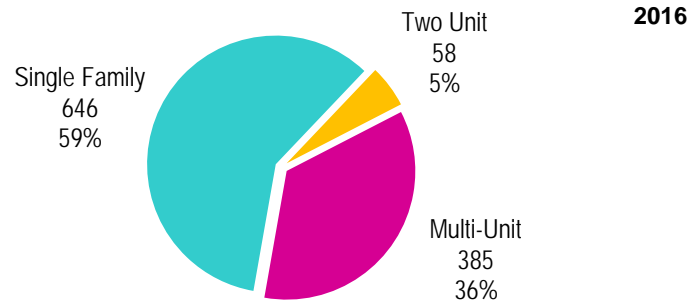

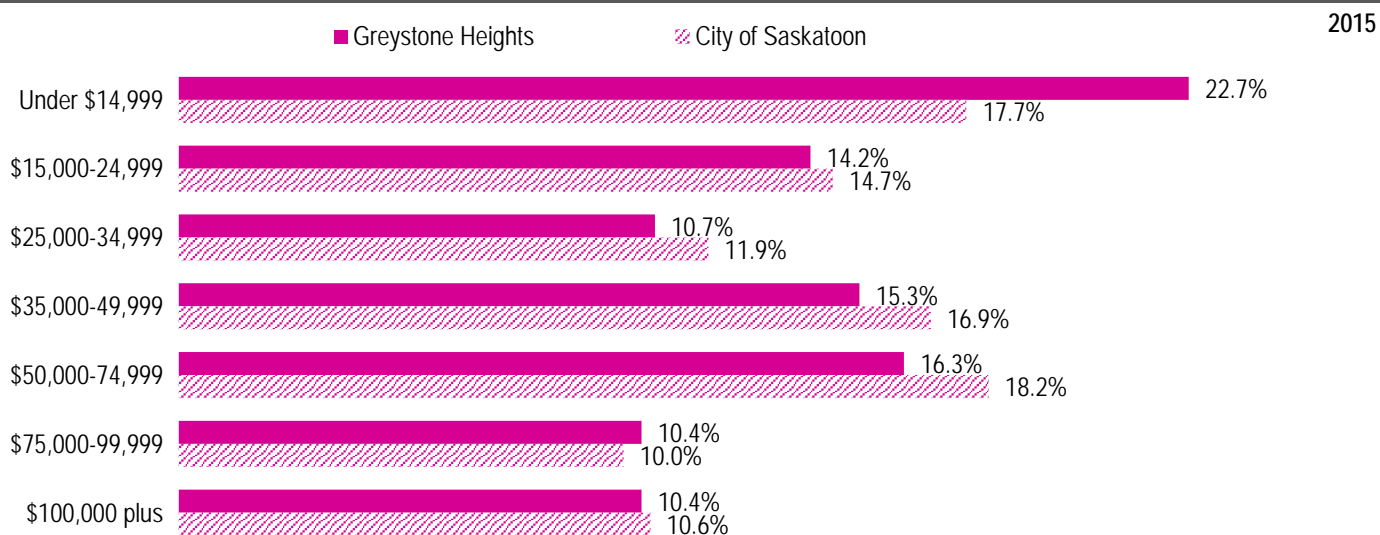

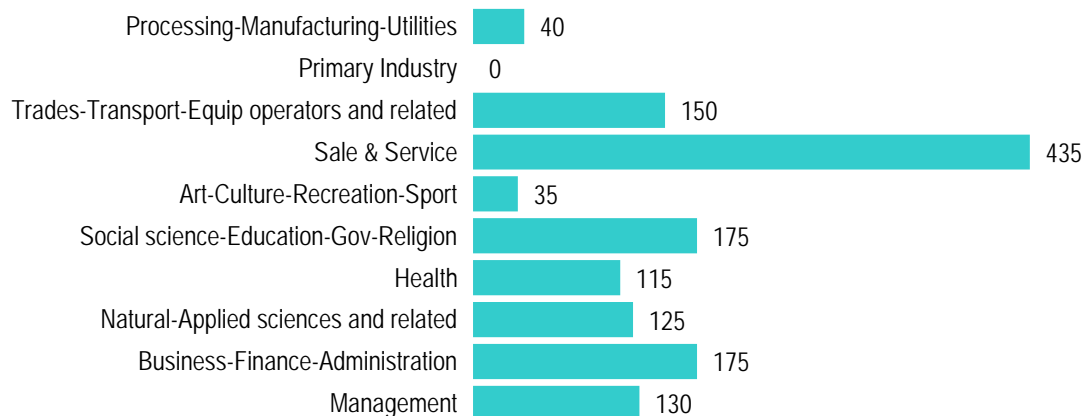
Personal Income
