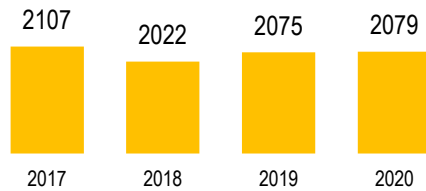

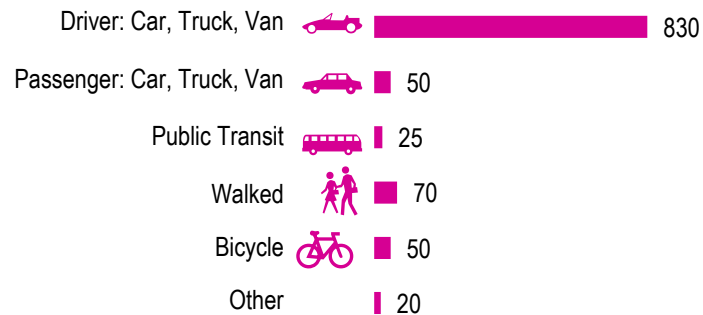

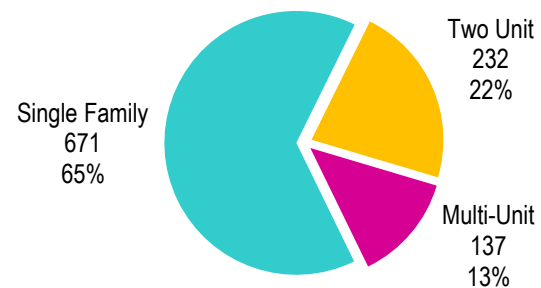

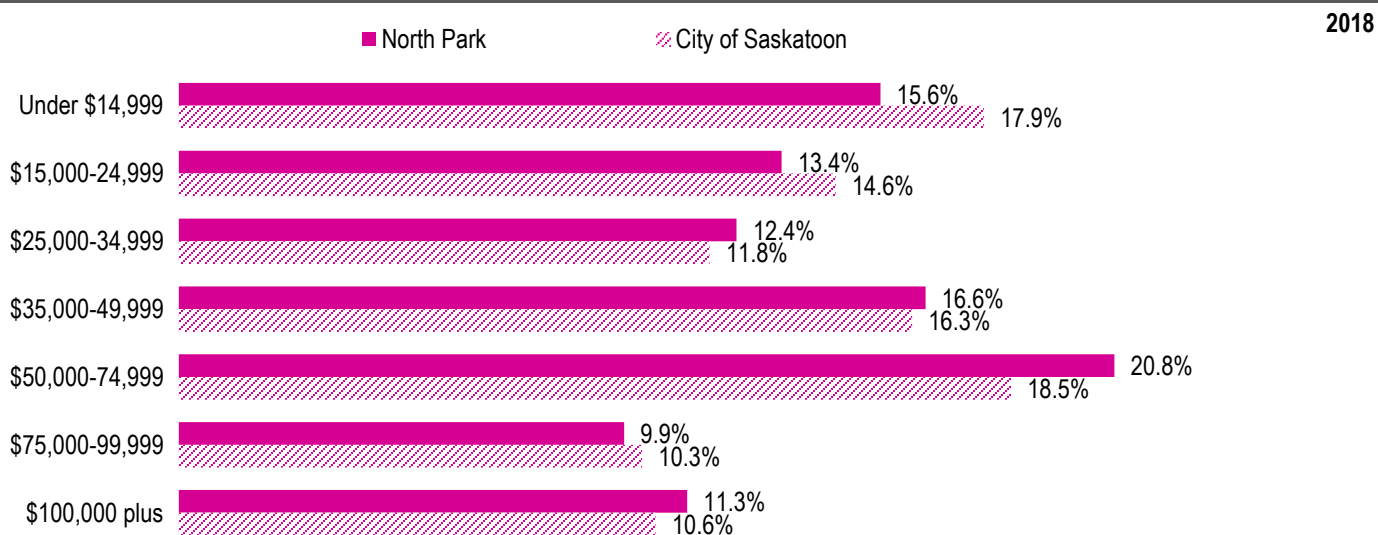

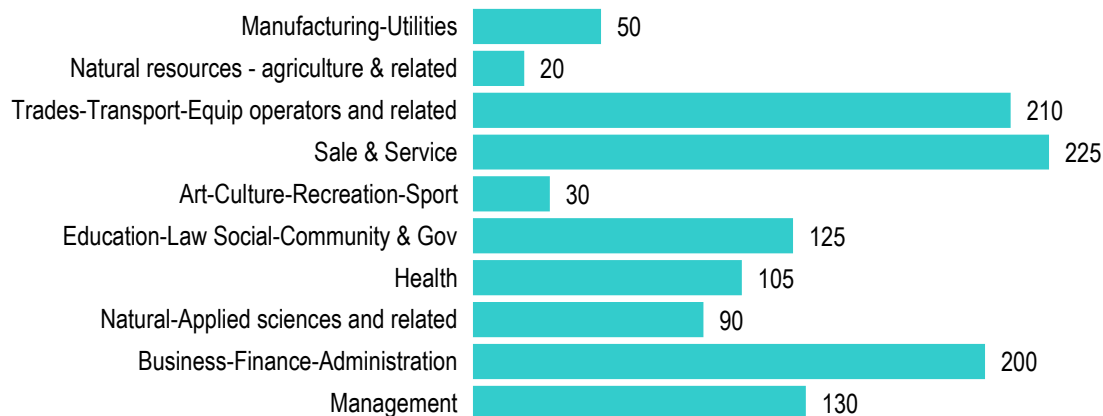
Personal Income
