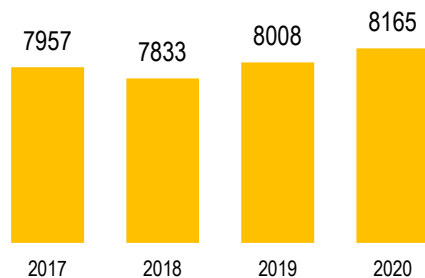

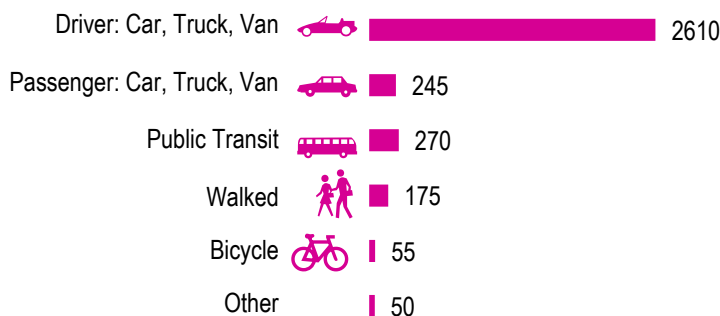

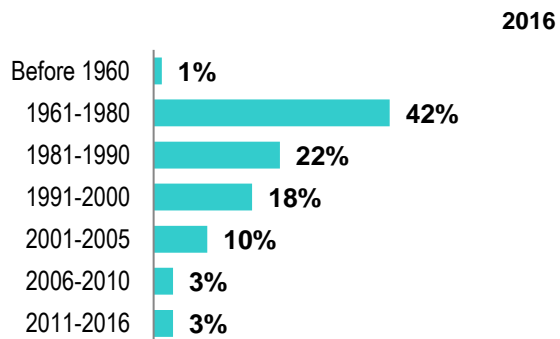

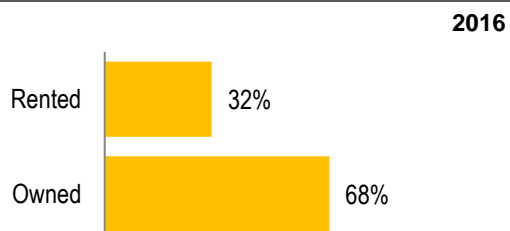

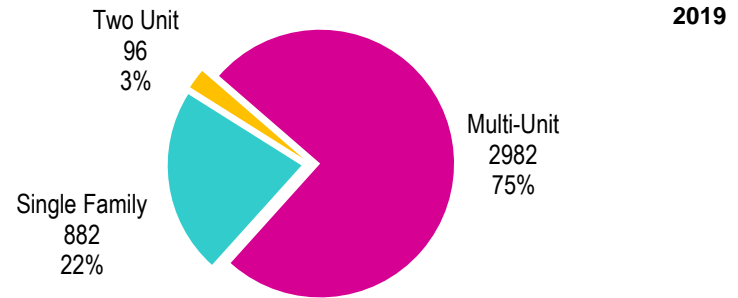

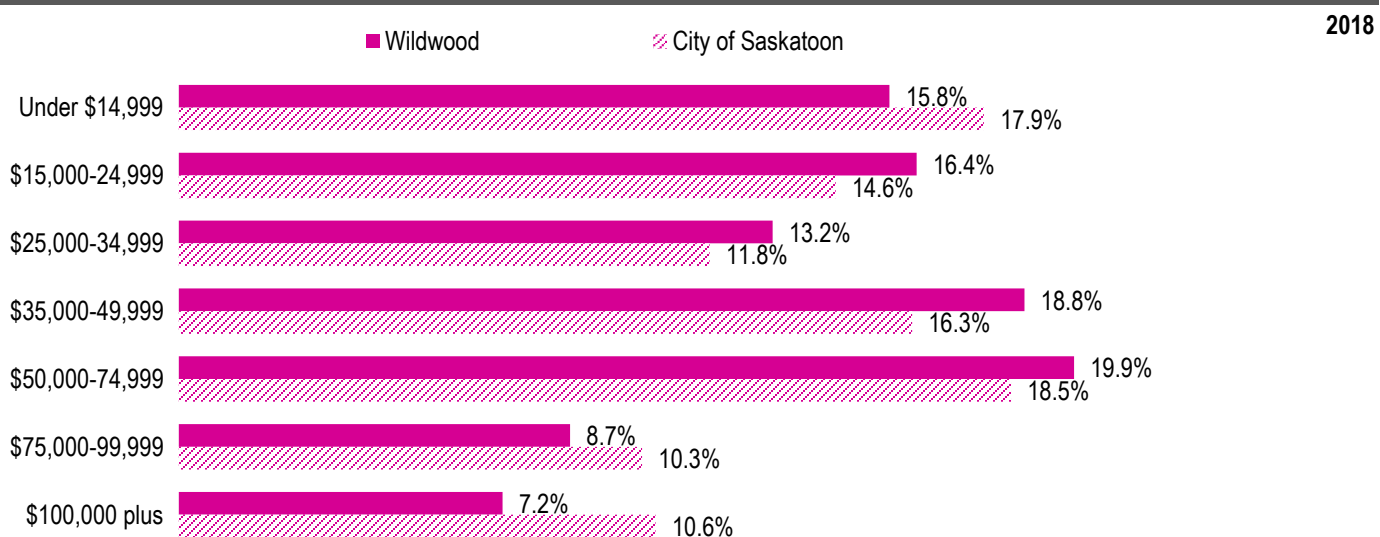

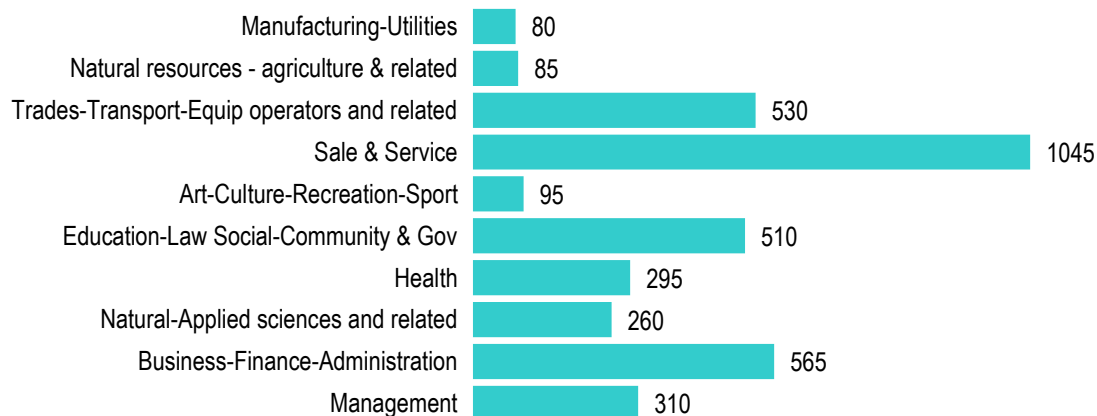
Personal Income
