


#### IDYLWYLD DRIVE @ 20TH STREET

The intersection of Idylwyld Drive and 20th Street is a key gateway opportunity, both for Saskatoon's Downtown and Riversdale Neighbourhoods. Redevelopment on the adjacent lots offers opportunity to create iconic architectural statements, to be complimented by standalone gateway features in the public realm.

To the north-west corner, which is the focal point of drivers exiting Senator Sid Buckwold Bridge, it is proposed to create a vertical landmark feature, one that is visible from Downtown along 20th Street E. Use of light will be key to make this a prominent landmark day and night, as if a beacon welcoming all to the city.

Kitty-corner from the north-west to the south-east corner, the potential for large scale redevelopment offers the opportunity for a large, interactive public artwork as the centre of a new public open space.
