



Royal Canadian Golf Association Rules Govern all Play except where modified by local rules

- Staked trees, sprinkler heads, maintenance equipment, roads and paths are immovable obstructions. Drop within one club-length

from the nearest point of relief (no closer to the hole). No penalty.

- All ponds are to be played as penalty areas.
- Out of bounds is defined by all permanent fences.

COURSE RULES

- Each player must register with the Pro Shop and have a set of golf clubs and a playing receipt before starting play.
- Repair ball marks on greens
- Replace all divots
- Rake all sandtraps
- Allow faster players to play through
- Do not wave up following players unless you are allowing them to play through

GOLF ETIQUETTE

- Keep all golf carts off the greens, tee boxes and away from roped areas. Keep golf bags off the greens.
- Repair tee box divots with sand and seed mixture provided for this purpose.

- When the hole is finished, move off the green at once. Report and mark your score at the next tee.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the golf course at any time. This is a criminal offence and will be treated as such.

- Golfers are expected to wear proper golf attire at all times including a full-bodied shirt and suitable shorts or pants. Gentlemen are recommended to wear shirts with sleeves; ladies may wear sleeveless shirts.

- Shirts must be worn at all times. Exposed midribs, strapless or halter tops, and bathing suits are not permitted.
- For your own personal safety, suitable footwear must be worn at all times which may include softspike golf shoes, running

shoes, sandals or soft-soled shoes. To prevent damage to the golf course, no heels over one half inch or boots of any kind are permitted. Playing in bare feet is not permitted.

NOTE: Do not drink water from the sprinkler heads, as it is untreated river water. Drinking water is available at water fountains. Please keep out of the water. The ponds on the golf course are deep.
