Kinsmen Park Festival Site Guidelines

Special events add cultural value to the City of Saskatoon and create opportunities where communities and neighbourhoods can come together and celebrate! Our corporation, the City of Saskatoon, exists to provide excellence in local governance and public service delivery. To achieve this, the use of the Kinsmen Park Festival Site will follow the guidelines and priorities set out in this document.

Objective: to allow use of the Kinsmen Park Festival Site to program outdoor events by ensuring:

- 1. Safety
 - Of the users; and
 - Of the whole community.
- 2. The impact to surrounding programming and amenities is minimized.
- 3. There is a greater benefit to the community at large.

Outdoor Events requesting to utilize the Kinsmen Park Festival Site must adhere to the following:

- 1. Alcohol sales/service is not permitted during operating hours of Nutrien Playland rides.
- 2. Amplified sound is not permitted during Shakespeare on the Saskatchewan performance hours.
- 3. Fencing may be required as part of the event and is the responsibility of the event organizer to arrange.
 - Type & size of the event will be considerations when determining fencing requirements.
- 4. Priority will be given to children/family events, as per the Kinsmen Park Masterplan.
