OCP - Official Community Plan (2020)

- · Policy and procedures for parks, natural areas, recreation, CPTED, climate, green infrastructure
- Detailed design requirements that affect Sector, Concept, Subdivision, Site Plans, and content of these plans

Green Infrastructure Strategy (2019)

• Analysis and mapping of existing parks, natural areas, objectives for climate + green infras.

NAI - Natural Areas Inventory (2019)

High level recommendations, detailed maps of natural features, natural species list to support Green Inf.
Strategy

UFMP - Urban Forestry Management Plan (2021)

- Map of Urban Forest
- Procedures for long-term planning, growth, management, and protection for Urban Forests

Policy C02-036 - Environmental Policy (2015 update)

- Definitions for biodiversity, sustainability, sustainable community
- Requires new and ex. City facilities to be designed, constructed, retrofitted and operated to reduce env. impacts through energy efficiency, water conservation, waste minimization, GHG reduction, pollution prevention

LECP - Low Emissions Community Plan (2019)

 Action Plan to reduce GHG emissions, requires municipal lighting to be LED, reduced-energy municipal buildings

LID - Low Impact Development Guideline (2016)

- Best practices for green roof, raintanks and cisterns, permeable paving, grass swales, bioretention, infiltration, SWM ponds, grading
- Some specific guidelines for streets, grading, planting, landscape maintenance

ATP - Active Transportation Plan (2016)

Action Plan to improve crossings and routes across the City based on stakeholder and public input, with maps

Complete Streets Design and Policy Guide (2017)

• Function, layout, street furniture per road type

DDSM - Design and Dev Standards Manual (ver 13)

• Section 8-streetscape - widths, setbacks, materials, sidewalks, MUP, cycling, boulevard, medians, buffers-per road type

Safe Growth and CPTED in Saskatoon (2010)

• Descriptions, guidelines with some details on parks and public places

Policy A09-034 - CPTED Review (2015 update)

• Procedures to evaluate dev applications, appendix with CPTED principles

FADS - Facility Accessibility Design Standards (2012)

• Detailed requirements (materials, siting, setbacks) for city-owned lands - bench, parking, planting, landscape materials, picnic tables, street furniture

- One brief recommendation for energy efficient design and green infrastructure (transit)

Policy A10-017 - Park Development Guidelines (2016 Update)

- Mix of high level and detailed requirements for park distribution and park design
- Detailed design requirements that affect Sector, Concept, Subdivision, Site Plans

LDDS - Landscape Design & Development Standards (2016)

- · Design standards according to park type and LID, including grading, irrigation pathways, lighting, planting, street furniture
- Procedures and requirements for Landscape Development Review Process, + overall standards for irrigation, play, etc.
- Definition of Buffer Strip, Street Tree size per road type, details for entry, medians, lay-by's round-abouts

Landscape Guidelines No. 8870 (2014)

• Submission requirements for landscape plans for commercial, employment, residential

Recreation Facilities and Parks Usage By-law (1998)

- Park definitions District, Linear, Multi-District, Neighbourhood Core, Neighbourhood Pocket, Riverbank, Special Use
- Provisions for permitted events and time slots for using parks

Policy C09-017 - Buffer Strip Construction (1980)

- Establishes location of buffer strips adjacent to highways, major industrial area, purpose +width to be determined at POS stage
- Eng Dept will design and construct all buffer strips with berms; parks dept will design and maintain all buffer strips without berms; Planning Dept will be responsible for changes and updates to the Policy

Policy C09-011 - Trees on City Property (2010)

• Tree-cutting permissions and restrictions on city policy

• Standard construction details for parks - planting, street furniture, sports, irrigation
