

Tasks completed by the City of Saskatoon (NO action required by residents)

Canada Post: Canada Post is providing <u>free mail forwarding service</u> until January 15, 2025. Postage-paid Change of Address cards are available for pick up at your local Post Office.

SGI: You should already have received an updated driver's license and/or non-drivers photo ID with your new address from Saskatchewan Government Insurance (SGI). If you have not, contact SGI at sgiinquiries@sgi.sk.ca or toll-free at 1-844-855-2744. If you have a Package Policy or additional auto insurance, please contact the SGI Canada insurance broker that issued the policy to notify them of the address change with them.

Land Titles: The City worked directly with Information Services Corporation (ISC) to have your property's land title changed for you. If you are the registered owner ISC will send to you directly a changed registration for your property.

Pet Licenses: Have been updated to reflect the new street name. Saskatoon Animal Control Agency has also been notified.

Blue Carts / Black Carts / Green Carts: Cosmo & Loraas have been contacted to ensure that recycling carts and bins are emptied as per their normal routine.

Maps: The City has notified Emergency Services for **911** calls as well as the Ministry of Highways and web mapping platforms.

Water Utilities (from City of Saskatoon): Have been updated.

SaskEnergy: has updated their files with the name change so your next energy bill should have the new road name on it.

SaskPower: has updated their files with the name change so your next power bill should have the new road name on it.

Saskatoon Public Library Cards: Ask to have it updated the next time you go to your nearest library branch.

For the Municipal Election in November 2024: Your new SGI drivers license will be what is needed for proof of eligibility to vote.
