Weed Management Pilot Program

The City of Saskatoon is working on a strategy to further improve our green spaces, specifically turf and sports field conditions. Parks and green spaces in Saskatoon, especially in newer neighbourhoods, are experiencing increased levels of weeds.

Based on a motion from City Council, the City has selected the northern portion of Prairie Lily Park in Brighton for a Green Space Weed Management pilot. Early this summer, one round of weed herbicide will be applied, followed by multiple courses of aerating, overseeding, topdressing, and fertilizing. This work will take place during the summer of 2025. Signage will be in place before and during spraying.

For effective reduction of green space weeds, treatments over more than one season are required, with additional reductions in weeds occurring each year. For the purposes of this pilot, results from the first season will be used as the basis to report back on the effectiveness of this approach and will inform future green space weed management.
