Special Instructions: The corona virus can cause infections of the nose, throat and lungs and are most commonly spread from an infected person through; respiratory droplets generated from a cough or a sneeze close, prolonged personal contact, such as touching or shaking hands touching something with the virus on it, then touching your mouth, nose or eyes before washing your hands To help prevent the spread of the virus, wash your hands with soap and water for a least 20 seconds and use alcohol based hand sanitizer when soap and water is not available. Cough and sneeze into the bend of your arm, not your hand. Dispose of any tissues after usage. Avoid touching your face, eyes or mouth with unwashed hands. Clean high touch surfaces disinfecting cleaners.
