About the Project

Rockingham Avenue between Crescent Boulevard and Caen Street will be reconstructed. The work will consist of removing the old deteriorated asphalt and base material, then reconstructing the road with a new base material and hot mix asphalt. This will extend the lifespan of the road and result in a smooth, level surface. Northern Blacktop has been awarded the contract.

There will be no access to driveways and no street parking on Rockingham Avenue between Crescent Boulevard and Caen Street during construction. The work is scheduled to begin in August and will last approximately two weeks, weather permitting.

The work will be completed in phases and is as follows, weather permitting:

Phase 1: Approximately five days

Rockingham Avenue between Crescent Boulevard and Merritt Street will receive road reconstruction

Phase 2: Approximately five days

Rockingham Avenue between Merritt Street and Caen Street will receive road reconstruction

✓ What you can expect:

1. Signs will be posted in advance to give notice of when the work will begin.
2. Barricades and signage will be installed to restrict traffic
3. Heavy machinery will be used to complete the work and will result in noise and vibration in your home.
4. Water and wet surfaces will delay this work. Weather can be a factor.
5. Emergency vehicles will still have access to the work site.
6. Watch for "Fresh Oil" signs and take appropriate measures to avoid contact with the oil, as it is difficult to remove from clothing, vehicles, and driveways.

🔗 How you can help:

1. Please stay out of the work zone. This is for your safety as well as the safety of our workers.
2. Please obey the traffic detours and no parking signs.
3. Don't water your lawns for the duration of the project, as it will delay the work.

Frequently Asked Questions

Will there be traffic restrictions?

Yes. Rockingham Avenue between Crescent Boulevard and Caen Street will be fully closed according to the construction phases.

Will parking be affected?

Yes. For households/businesses adjacent to the work in progress, access to on-street parking will be restricted and alternative parking will need to be used around the neighbourhood. Please contact the engineer listed below.

Will my garbage and recycling collection services be affected?

No. The garbage and recycling collection services will not be affected.

Will my water and sewer service be affected?

No. The City is not expecting any water or sewer interruptions.

Will the bus routes change?

Bus routes along the construction route may be affected throughout the project. During construction, please check the signs posted for alternate bus stop locations or call Saskatoon Transit at 306-975-3100.

Will rain delay completion of the work?

Yes. Rain could delay the project. If rain delays are experienced, the schedule will be shifted accordingly.

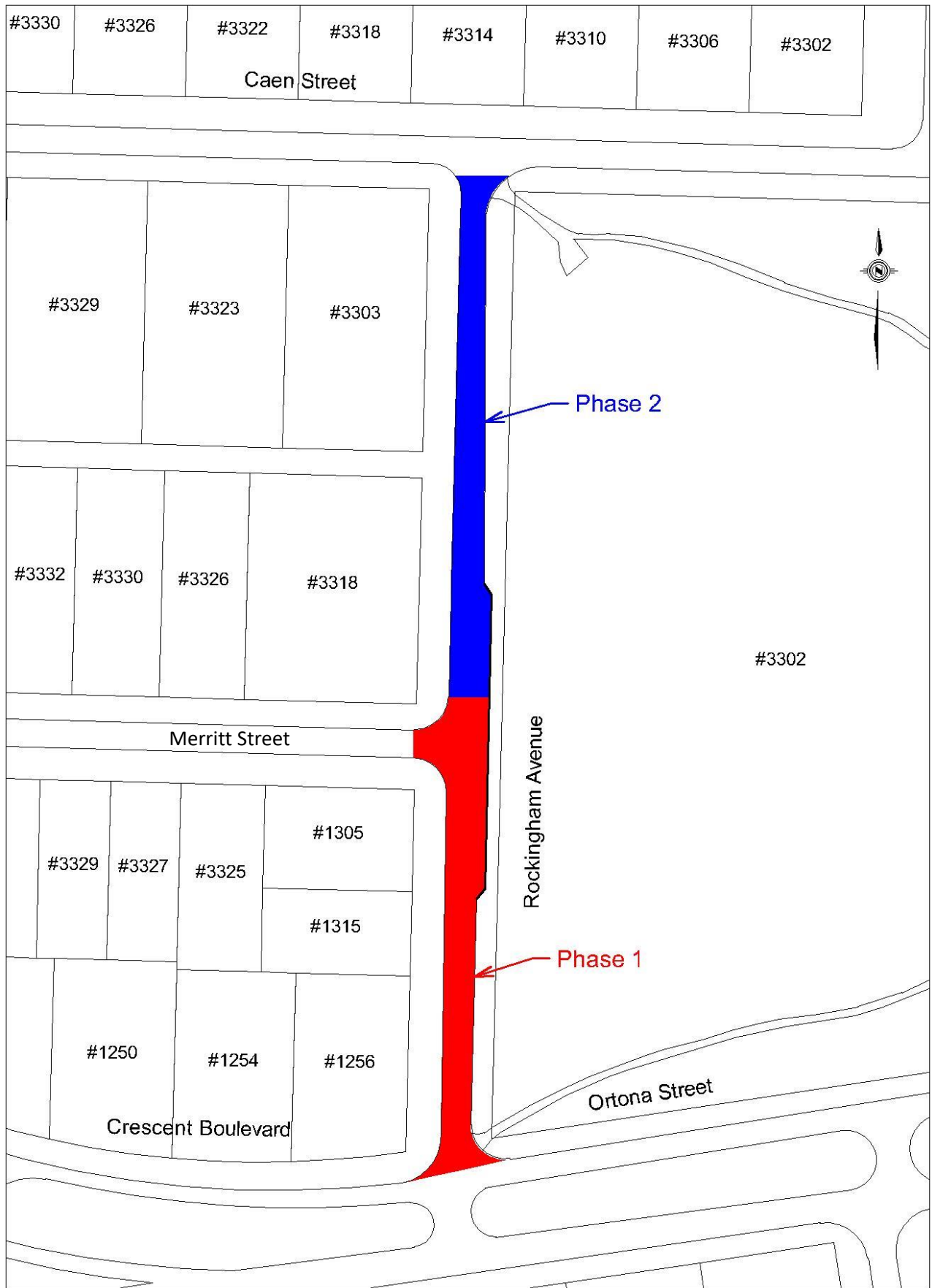
