

2019-2020

2019 Work Zones

- Avenue F South from 17th St W to 20th St W
- Avenue E South from Spadina Cres W to 19th St W
- Avenue D South from Spadina Cres W to 18th St W
- > 18th Street West from Ave D S to Ave F S

2020 Work Zones

- Avenue G South from 16th St W to 20th St W
- 17th Street West from Spadina Cres W to Ave H S






Order of Work

- 1. Sewer Lining
- 2. Temp water set up
- 3. Connection Replacement
- 4. Water Main Replacement
- 5. Road Resurfacing
- 6. Final Site Restoration




Sewer Lining





- Cured-in-Place-Pipe (CIPP) liner
- Done before water main rehab work
- Done before connection work
- Fast; non-invasive







Temporary Water Supply

Made up of 3 components



Temporary Supply (hydrant)





Temporary Water Main (pipes)





Temporary House Connection (hoses)




Outside Taps with Backflow Preventers

- Outside taps that have a backflow prevention device will not accept the temporary water
- The backflow preventer will have to be removed/disabled by the homeowner
 - Recommend using a licensed plumber

Existing Connections

- All homes have service connection pipes running to both the water main and the sanitary sewer main
- The City of Saskatoon intends to replace all existing lead water service connections by the end of 2027






Why replace connections?


- Lead water service connections MUST be replaced during water main replacement because the disturbed lead connection pipe could lead to increased lead in your water
- Sanitary service pipes constructed of tar fiber are to be replaced with longer lasting PVC connection pipe



Traditional Repair Method




Trenchless Repair Methods


























Connection Payment Options

- Three payment methods:
 - 1. Pay the Contractor directly
 - Short term deferral
 - 1-year, 3-year, and 5-year options
 - 3. Long term deferral
 - Available only to people who meet the federal LICO criteria



Order of Operations

- Homeowners will be contacted by the City of Saskatoon
- Information will be mailed to homeowners
- The Contractor will contact the homeowner for a walkthrough of the home
- The Contractor will confirm the date of the work and will arrange access to the home
- Typically connection work lasts one day



Other Information

- Water will be turned off during the connection replacement
- Contractor is only responsible to backfill excavations on private property
- Homeowners are responsible for surface restoration on private property


