7 steps to help you reduce the risk of storm water in your basement this summer

Extend downspouts at least six feet from your basement walls to help keep water away from the foundation and weeping tile.

Clean debris from your eavestroughs to prevent them from overflowing.
Build up the ground slope around your homeso water flows away from your basement walls.

Check the drainage paths on your property to ensure storm water flows to the lane or street, not towards your home.
Repair all leaks in walls, floors, windows and doors.
Install window wells around basement windows to help prevent window sills from rotting and leaking.
If you have protective plumbing such as you have protective plumbing such, make sure
backflow valves and sump pumps,they are working properly.
