

Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory Lifted

LOCATION

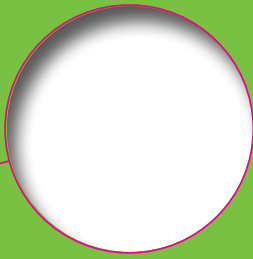
The Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory that had been in effect for your area is now over. The drinking water has been proven to be bacteriologically safe to consume. You may begin using your tap water as normal after you complete the following steps:

Before you consume the water:

- Run cold water faucets and drinking fountains for at least 1 minute before using the water.
- Drain and flush the ice-making system in your refrigerator.
- Run water softeners through a regeneration cycle.
- Drain and refill hot water heaters set below 45°C (normal setting is 60°C).

Our number one priority is to ensure a clean and safe public water supply, and to provide the highest quality drinking water possible.
