

## YOUR NEW METER

Your new meter is electronic. It uses a digital method to display your electrical usage and will cycle through four different modes:



### Mode 1: Test of the display.

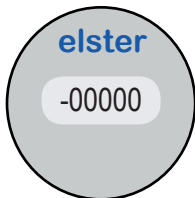
The test register displays eights in this formation: 88:88:88. This sequence shows that the meter is working correctly.



### Mode 2: Displays the amount of power delivered to your home.

Please record all six digits when entering a meter reading online or on a self-read card.

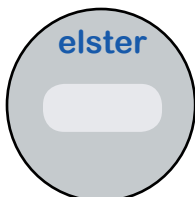


**Mode 3: Displays the amount of power given back to Saskatoon Light & Power (for customers that produce surplus power from their own generation).** Note: This mode may not display on all meters.

Unless your home is producing electricity, this register will display a minus sign and five zeros: -00000.



**Mode 4: This indicates that your meter is registered to an AMI data collector, and displays the registration number of the data collector.**
