## Give us your feedback on proposed traffic changes in your neighbourhood!

The City is undertaking a Neighbourhood Traffic Review for Lawson Heights/Lawson Heights Suburban Centre and inviting your input. The neighbourhood is bound by Lenore Drive (north), Spadina Crescent (east), Warman Road (west) and Primrose Drive/La Ronge Road (south).

This review was initiated in April 2019. Thank you to everyone that has offered us input so far. We received your feedback via [Saskatoon.ca/engage](https://saskatoon.ca/engage), email, phone calls and in-person at the first meeting held on April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

We have reviewed all the concerns and followed up with data collection (e.g. traffic counts, speed analysis, field observations, etc.). The result is a draft Traffic Plan that proposes changes to the way traffic moves around your neighbourhood.

The draft plan will be discussed at the public meeting and posted to [Saskatoon.ca/engage](https://saskatoon.ca/engage) and [Saskatoon.ca/ntr](https://saskatoon.ca/ntr) after the meeting date. We would appreciate the opportunity to get your thoughts on our draft plan. Please note that this is the last public meeting regarding your neighbourhood's new traffic plan.
