



CITY OF SASKATOON – EXCESS LOAD - DIMENSION REFERENCE

LICENSED EXCESS LOADS

WIDTH (Any loads less than or equal to 2.6 metres in width are considered legal)		
> 2.6 metres	Red flags on the extremities of the load overhanging the sides or rear of vehicles	
> 3.05 metres	"Oversized Load" Sign at the rear, in addition to the above requirements	
> 3.3 metres	A minimum of one amber flashing or rotating beacon visible for 200 metres, in addition to the above requirements	
> 5.0 metres	One pilot vehicle (rear only), in addition to the above requirements	
> 5.49 metres	Two pilot vehicles (one front and one rear)	
> 7.32 metres	Police assistance is required	

LENGTH (Any loads less than or equal to 25.0 metres in length are considered legal)		
> 25.0 metres	"Oversized Load" Sign at the rear	
> 27.5 metres	Amber beacon, in addition to the above requirements	
> 31.0 metres	"Oversized Load" Sign at the front, in addition to the above requirements	
> 34.0 metres	One pilot vehicle, in addition to the above requirements	
> 38.0 metres	Two pilot vehicles, in addition to the above requirements	
> 42.0 metres	Police assistance is required	

^{**}L.C.V. Units (Long Combination Vehicles) are the only exception to the length requirements, a permit is still required for an over-length vehicle, but they would not need to adhere to the above flagging and pilot vehicle requirements**

HEIGHT (Any loads less than or equal to 4.15 metres are considered legal)		
> 5.2 metres	Request is reviewed as a Vessel/Building move, review of the request may take	
	anywhere from five to ten business days	

UNLICENSED EXCESS LOADS

All unlicensed vehicles/equipment require a permit regardless of the dimensions, the vehicle/equipment must have an operating beacon and signal lights or be accompanied by a pilot vehicle

WIDTH	> 3.6 metres requires one pilot vehicle, > 4.0 metres requires two pilot vehicles
LENGTH	Follow the same requirements set out for Licensed Excess Loads
HEIGHT	Follow the same requirements set out for Licensed Excess Loads

TIME OF DAY RESTRICTIONS

WIDTH -	Licensed Vehicle	> 3.6 metres may not travel between 07:00-09:00 and 16:00-18:00, > 6.1 metres may not travel between 07:00-19:00
		> 3.6 metres may not travel between 07:00-09:00 and 16:00-18:00, > 4.0 metres may not travel between 07:00-19:00
