ENERGY EFFICIENCY HOME EVALUATION (ENERGY AUDIT)

What is an *EnerGuide Energy Efficiency Home Evaluation* or an "energy audit"?

- An *EnerGuide Energy Efficiency Home Evaluation*, or energy audit, is an in-person assessment of your home to understand its energy performance. The home is given an EnerGuide rating that indicates how much energy your home uses compared to other homes.
- The energy audit is completed by a professional energy advisor who will inspect your home for air tightness, insulation levels, evaluate the size and efficiency of your heating and cooling equipment, and review any other information related to your home's energy performance.
- The energy advisor will take photos of the outside of your house, mechanical systems (furnace, air conditioning, etc.), attic space, and any woodburning appliances for quality assurance and record keeping.
- After your audit is complete you will receive the following:
 - An EnerGuide rating and label
 - A homeowner information sheet
 - A Renovation Upgrade Report

What do they cost?

- Energy audits done by a certified EnerGuide advisor typically cost \$400–500 for the pre-project energy audit and \$200–300 for the post-project energy audit. The cost may be higher for large homes.
- Up to \$600 for the cost of the audits can be reimbursed if you register for <u>Canada Greener</u> <u>Homes Grant Program</u>, but you must register for this grant before you complete the audits.

Who can do energy audits?

- Only an EnerGuide Advisor certified by Natural Resources Canada (NRCan)can complete energy audits, you cannot perform an EnerGuide audit on your own home.
- In Saskatchewan, there are many organizations that can complete energy audits for HELP.
 NRCan's website has a <u>complete list</u> of the companies that can do this work.

What are the benefits of an energy audit?

- After a pre-project audit, a certified EnerGuide advisor will give you unbiased, customized advice on upgrades for your home that will have the greatest impact on energy use, home comfort, utility bills, and reduction in pollution (greenhouse gases).
 - The results of an energy audit can help you set priorities for renovations based on your customized needs and budget.
- Energy audits are mandatory to participate in incentive programs like Canada Greener Homes, SaskEnergy's Home Efficiency Retrofit Rebates and the City's Home Energy Loan Program.
