Exit ramps from College Drive onto McOrmond Drive will open Wednesday

The exit ramps for eastbound traffic on College Drive to go northbound or southbound on McOrmond Drive, will open on Wednesday, October 31. Opening the ramps will create free-flow traffic, eliminating the need for College Drive traffic to turn right from the eastbound lane in order to go northbound or southbound on McOrmond Drive. The College Drive and McOrmond Drive interchange is one of two under the Saskatoon Interchange Project. It opened on October 17 and the interchange at Boychuk Drive and Highway 16 opened on September 30. Construction on both interchanges started in April 2017 and both are expected to be totally complete by the end of July 2019.

Drivers are reminded that the speed limit through the work zones at both interchange sites is 60 km/h. For more information about the project, including renderings and video updates, visit saskatoon.ca/interchanges.
