Ahtahkakoop Cree Nation (ACN) is located near Shell Lake, Saskatchewan, approximately 150 kilometres north of Saskatoon. ACN is committed to providing an exceptional quality of life for their members through the provision of health and education services. ACN “is a forward looking and progressive community that has a vision to build a strong and healthy foundation using the guiding principles of Chief Ahtahkakoop, ‘let us not think of ourselves, but of our children’s children’” (<https://www.ahtahkakoop.ca/>).

HIGHLIGHTS AND OPPORTUNITIES

- Ahtahkakoop Cree Nation is a member of Treaty 6 and became a signatory in 1876.
- ACN’s home reserve encompasses roughly 43,000 acres.
- An Urgent Care Centre is under construction at 1930 20th Street West which is the site of the former Pleasant Hill elementary school. When completed, it will offer an alternative to emergency departments for minor illness, injuries and mental health and addiction supports that are non-life-threatening but require immediate care. The urgent care centre will be operated by the Saskatchewan Health Authority under a long-term lease with Ahtahkakoop Cree Developments. The former school building will be preserved and is planned to be reused for medical, office, institutional and community functions.
- ACN also have business developments including retail and insurance located outside of Saskatoon.

Services available on ACN's home reserve include Health Centre and Holistic Wellness Team; Know Your Status program; Justice Program and Justice Team; Athletics Program; Ahtahkakoop Child & Family Services Inc.; Cree Nations Treatment Haven; Fred Sasakamoose Arena.

Chief Ahtahkakoop School is part of the Treaty Six Education Council, and its mission is to “create a caring, sharing and daring environment where each child can achieve his or her potential and is able to cope with the ever-changing future” (<https://www.oak104.ca/>). The school offers a remote learning hub, counseling, career and academic advising, a drivers’ education program, and a student summer program. ACN also supports post-secondary students through scholarships, transition preparedness, job placement, and internship allowances.
