Park Upgrade and Construction



Brooke Park Update



The City is continuing work to advance Brooke Park, a 9-hectare neighbourhood park planned to include pathways, pathway lighting, irrigation, a ball diamond, tree and shrub plantings, park furnishings and signage.

To address current site conditions, Parks has completed mowing, trimming, litter control and, where feasible, foxtail seed head collection and will continue to monitor the site until construction starts.

Construction Timeline

Parks is working toward rough grading, drainage and stormwater-related work in September 2026, targeting completion in October 2026. This work will be subject to weather, site conditions, procurement timelines and contractor availability. An update will be provided once contractor schedule is finalized.

The remaining park construction is anticipated to begin in spring 2027, weather permitting.

Resident Impacts

During construction, residents may experience temporary noise, dust, equipment movement and access restrictions. Contractors will be expected to minimize impacts wherever possible. The site will be closed to the public and we kindly ask residents to respect all posted signs and fencing.
