

SUBSIDIZED SPAY AND NEUTER PROGRAM

The Subsidized Spay and Neuter Program (SSNP) helps low-income pet owners in Saskatoon get their pets spayed or neutered.

Who Can Apply?

Must be a permanent resident of Saskatoon for at least one year.
Household income must fall below Statistics Canada Low-Income Cut-Off.

Required Documents

Previous year's Notice of Assessment for each income earner in the household.

Proof of residency. (Utility bill issued within the last month showing applicant name and address).

Application period opens in January each year.
